

Realizing the pulse that for growth and development in the field of teacher education, the trios 'Innovation, Quality and Excellence' should go hand in hand, the institution organized a 3 day International seminar to bring about a paradigm shift in educational practices. An exhibition of publications from 18 professional colleges including teacher education colleges, different publishing firms and research centre was inaugurated at 2.p.m by Dr.S.V. Murugaprasad, Principal, Younus Institute of Technology, Kannanallur Kollam.

The Seminar was inaugurated by Dr Sunandha Edke, Chairman, CTE, Maharashtra. 
DR N D JOSHI INSTITUTIONAL EXCELLENCE AWARD

Orientation CUM SEMINAR ON REVISED B.ED CURRICULUM

The B.Ed course curriculum underwent revision and came into effect from the academic year 2013-14. The revised curriculum incorporating new content, new approaches and methodology was meant to equip the prospective teachers with the knowledge, skills, attitude, competence and commitment to face the challenges of the 21st century. For the workable curriculum to be effectively transacted, the Institution organized an orientation for EDU.03.Technology, Assessment and Evaluation on 5th November 2013 and a general session on the whole curriculum on 16th December 2013. The sessions were handled by Dr G R Santhosh Kumar (Chairman, Board of Studies, University of Kerala) and Smt. Laithambika Devi (KUCTE, Nedumangad) and Smt. Lekshmy (Asst. Prof. NSS Training College, Pandalam). Along with a proper orientation on the course frame work and mode of assessment, apprehensions regarding the curriculum were properly dealt.



Orientation ON CYBER CRIME

Cyber crimes are increasing at an alarming rate and has posed great threats to human values. In this backdrop, the institution organized an orientation class on cyber crime for BA, B.Com students of Learners' Support Centre on 7th January 2014. The class was led by Mr Krishnakumar (Asst Commissioner of Police, Kollam) Instances of Cyber Crime including fraudulent emails, peeping into the private virtual lives of unsuspecting social network users, unethical hacking on social networking site, uploading inappropriate content that invite character assassination were discussed.

The class ended with a warning to the student community not to be caught into the clutches of destructive technological wizards and become victims or partners of cyber crime.



COMMUNITY LIVING CAMP

A four day residential community camp was organized in the college campus from 20th to 23rd May 2014. All the student teachers and teacher educators were part and parcel of the camp.
