# NAAC Sponsored NATIONAL SEMINAR

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell of the College (IQAC) organized a 2 day NAAC Sponsored National Seminar on 10th and 11th December 2013. The seminar was Inaugurated by Dr B Sandhya IPS (Additional Director General of Kerala Police, Armed Police Battalion). Dr a Younus Kunju (Ex. MLA) Chairman Fathima Memorial Educational Trust delivered the Presidential address. The thematic sessions were led by Dr. B William Dharma Raja, Associate Professor, MS University, Tirunelveli and Dr S Kadiravan Asso. Prof and Head, Dept of Psychology, Periyar University.

The topic for the seminar was 'Best Practices In Education For 21st Century' the sub themes were: Principles of Best Practices, Standards of Best Practices, Models of Best Practices, Pros and Cons in Best Practices, Institutional Constraints for Best Practices and Innovative ideas in Best Practices. The seminar aimed to bring academicians, teacher educators, researchers and those concerned with education to a common platform focusing on the best practices for sharing ideas expertise and suggestions for evolving best practices in achieving institutional excellence. Paper presentations were conducted in three parallel sessions. About 40 papers of the different discussion themes were presented.

The Valedictory function was presided over by Mr. Y Noushad, Vice Chairman of the college. Research scholars, teachers and teacher educators exchanged their experiences of the seminar. Dr Mini K S, Vice Principal, FMTC and Organizing Secretary proposed the vote of thanks.
